If you have a learning disability, you should get your ears and hearing checked.



The **audiology** team helps you to look after your ears and keep them healthy.



The audiology team can check your ears and hearing if you have never had a hearing test.

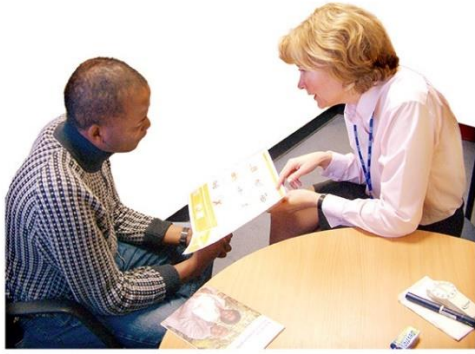


The audiology team can also help you if your ears:

- hurt
- leak liquid
- itch
- make funny noises



An **audiologist** is a health professional who looks after your ears.



The audiologist can talk to you and your carer about how to look after your ears.



The audiologist can help you to see a special doctor at the hospital about your ears.



The audiologist can help you to get a hearing aid from the hospital.



The audiologist can help you get equipment to hear things better at home, like your doorbell or phone.
